Chamely was grown up in a very poor household. In 1995, she married Akther Hossain, an unemployed young guy who had nothing at that time. But he had two assets. One was a big dream and another was the inspiration of Chamely. It was so struggling for them to make the dream true. They started their doth business from footpath. The only source of investment was her wedding ornament. They realized, with same effort if they could increase investment, it would be more profitable.



As changing reagent National Development Programme-NDP entered their life in 2003. NDP provided her 60,000 taka as Micro-Enterprise Loan. They leased 20 weaving machine in Bezgati Bazar. With the assistance of NDP they have steadily expanded his business, acquiring more machines, hiring workers, and selling more products. Now they have 4 factories where 28 power looms are running and 10 more power looms are under construction. They have created 97 jobs so far, along with supporting their own family, and have plans to keep growing. Their only daughter is higher secondary level student getting preparation to get admission in Engineering School. NDP not only gave them lone, but also courage to move forward.
